

Bathroom Checklist

- While considering your budget for your bathroom - Average Cost of a Bathroom Remodel
The average bathroom remodel costs \$11,031 Most homeowners spend between \$6,606 and \$16,425. You can spend as little as \$3,500 to \$7,000 updating the essentials in a small or medium-sized bathroom. On a large or master bath, you could spend \$25,000 or more.

Shower	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • You will need to consider whether you would like a custom shower pan or acrylic insert which would mean an additional \$2,500
Vanity	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The biggest thing to consider is what is the lead time on shipping in the current market

Flooring Material	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Take your time deciding on what floor you'd like to use in your home. Sheet vinyl, LVP, and/or tile. (We do strongly recommend staying away from laminate flooring in a bathroom)
Floor Trim	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Decide between your choice of wood baseboard or tile baseboard.
Shower Door	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Look Out! Custom glass can cost between \$2,500-\$3,500. If this is the route you'd like to take, the glass contractor will come measure once the tile work is complete. The lead time is usually 4-6 weeks to install after they take the measurements. Standard semi frames shower doors can cost between \$1,000-\$1,500 installed. Economy grade doors cost \$800-\$1,000 once installed
